USW Post-Secondary Scholarship


Twenty-one post-secondary education scholarships reserved for Canadian USW members in good standing, or their children, graduating high school and starting post-secondary studies this fall.

Scholarships are awarded based on an original essay on a selected union topic and post-secondary acceptance.

To apply: Submit an application form, supporting documents and an original 1,000-word essay. See www.usw.ca/scholarships for full scholarship details.

Eligibility: Canadian USW members in good standing, or their children, graduating high school and starting post-secondary education this fall.

Amount: \$1,000 Deadline: June 30, 2017



David Ellis Scholarship

Five \$500 scholarships to high school students who are children or grandchildren of USW members, to help continue their education at a post-secondary institution.

Scholarships are awarded to high school students who write a winning essay or produce a three-to-five minute YouTube video on health and safety.

Eligibility: Children or grandchildren of USW members who are high-school students entering post-secondary education.
