

## COVID-19 UPDATE: Another Regina teammate tests positive.

### REMINDER: Everyone must wear face coverings at EVRAZ Regina

Another Regina teammate, a member of one of our maintenance crews, this week has reported testing positive for COVID-19. We have quickly conducted contact tracing connected to this new case. That tracing has identified a number of potentially exposed teammates that now are going into quarantine, consistent with public health guidelines.

Coronavirus numbers are climbing rapidly across the province and we now have seen multiple teammates contract the illness here in Regina.

For the last several months of this pandemic, it may not have been top of mind for many inside our facilities day to day and shift to shift. Today, the time for complacency is over. We all must immediately rededicate ourselves to taking the simple steps we've all become so familiar with to reduce COVID risks in our workplace.

- **Wear your mask - inside, on your way inside, all the time.**
- Maintain your social distance, wherever possible
